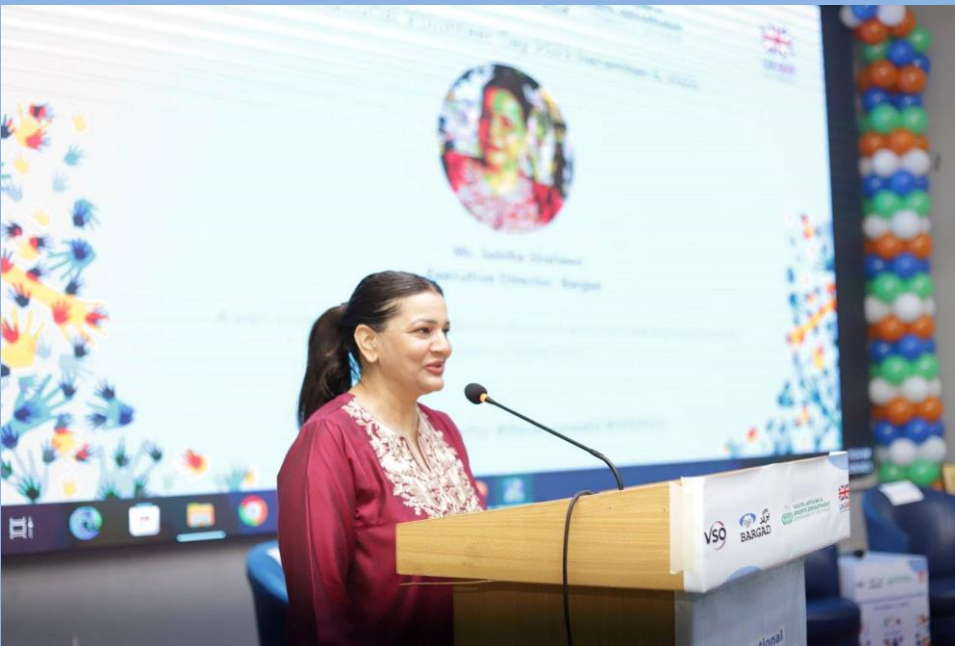

ABOUT BARGAD

Having executed around 100 project with national and international donor, it has the distinction of bringing youth into national and provincial policy domains and was instrumental in the formulation of pioneering youth policies (Punjab 2012, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa 2016 and Sindh 2018) among other initiatives. The organization has a credible history of working with higher education institutes and government bodies through 34 MOUs and other partnerships. It has trained around 800,000 students, faculty members and youth activists through its 33 manuals.

Bargad's strong social media presence includes over 39,000 Facebook followers, 21,400 on Instagram, 4,680 on Twitter, and 2.1K YouTube subscribers. The Bargad Volunteer Network (BVN) has over 3,000 volunteers in 86 universities and 84 districts across Pakistan.



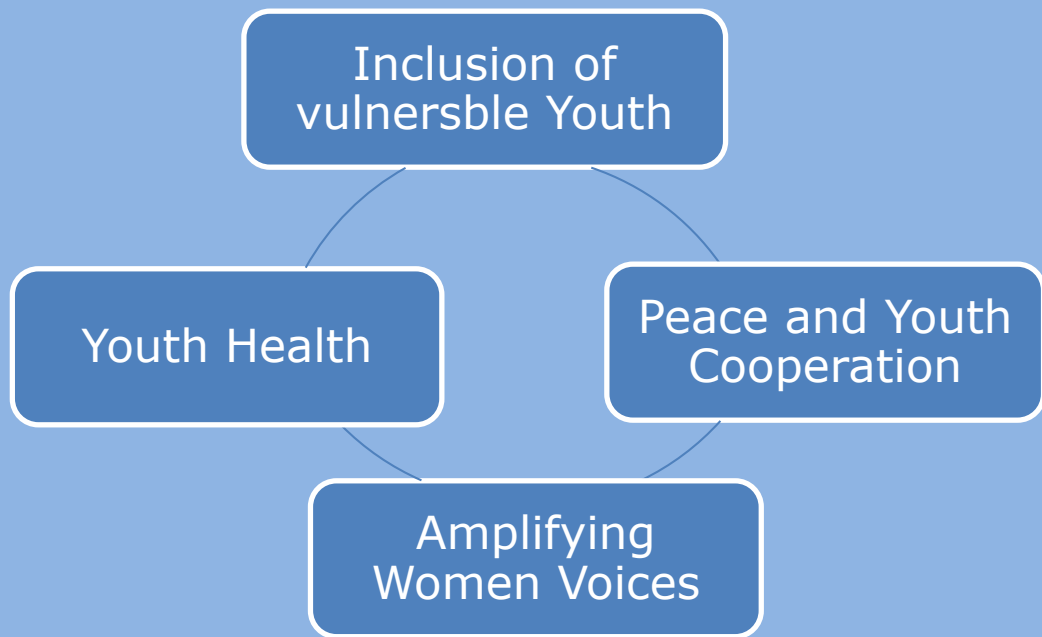

Bargad Volunteers' Network



BVN is a youth-led volunteer network working in 76 universities and 90 districts of all provinces of Pakistan including Islamabad Capital Territory; Azad Jammu and Kashmir; Gilgit-Baltistan, and Federally Administered Tribal Areas. The Objective of the BVN are: 1) promoting volunteerism through collective actions; 2) celebrating diversity through provincial and regional exchange programmes, and 3) creating virtual and physical space for youth expressions.

BVN has extended its network up to 3572 members in which 1829 are females and 1743 are males. BVN this year hire two BVN coordinators:

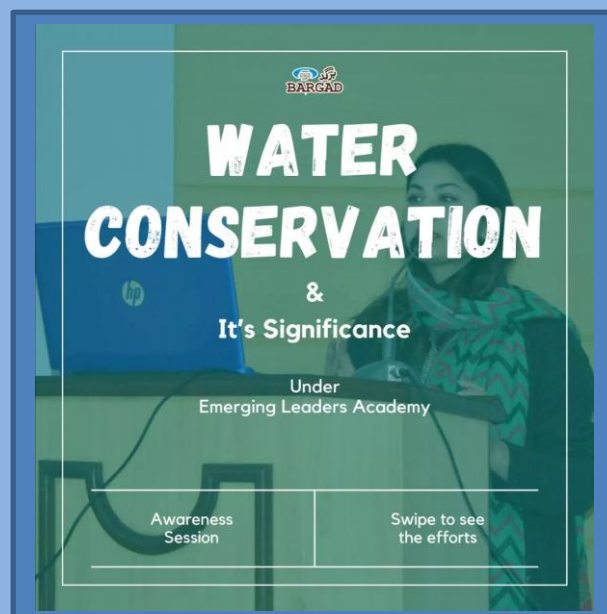

Bargad successfully carries out its important features every year as Bargad celebrated International Youth and Volunteer Days in Lahore and Islamabad with massive gathering of youth. The events are the driving force behind positive change and youth came together to showcase their creativity, determination, and dedication to making the world a better place



2% Quota Registration

The dissemination of information regarding the 2% quota has resulted in a vast increase in the number of students availing the quota. With the extended efforts the numbers have increased from 86 to 246 students availing the 2% quota in Punjab alone.



Positive Influencing

Bargad's work over the last two years with Police Training Center Chung has resulted in increased sensitization towards minority rights. They have even constructed a church on their premises for their Christian recruits.



Joint Celebrations

Faith based gatherings like Holi, Diwali, Christmas, Eid Milad ul Nabi etc are also add into achievements of Bargad which always brings positive results. The joint celebrations have become the prominent feature of Bargad. The minorities enjoy celebrating and wait for such events throughout the year.



our Projects

1. Youth Volunteering for Inclusive Development

The project was implemented with the support of Voluntary Services Overseas- VSO from September 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024 to increase uptake and application of Global Standard for Volunteering by a number of stakeholders and supporting local volunteers and marginalized, vulnerable people as empowered active participants in civic action or locally led development programmes.

2. Young Omang

Bargad has been part of the network since 2018 as an advocacy and lobbying expert. Young Omang is focused on Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) in Pakistan. In 2022, the network secured a grant from Amplify Change and will end in 2025. During the current year, as part of the project Bargad has capacitated two grass root level CSOs for organizational development and sensitized them on child marriages.

3. Emerging Leaders Academy

The Emerging Leaders Academy is a remarkable initiative aimed at fostering leadership and community development. The project is from 01 July 2023–8 May 2024. Under the project 4 provincial workshops have been successfully executed. The project is a trailblazing initiative to nurture individuals into positive catalysts for change. Selected leaders from this workshop would be able to attend advanced training, boost their professional trajectory, and secure community grants to conduct their SAPs.



4. Communities of Hope: Intra and Inter-faith Harmony for Sustainable Peace

With the support of NCA, the project addressed the issues of religiously motivated violent extremism and hate speech through promotion of social cohesion, intra/interfaith dialogue, and cooperation initiatives in 8 union councils of Lahore and Gujranwala. The project promoted 2% minority quota and resolved 15 conflicts in communities

5. My Dream, My Business

The project started in 2022 and will end in 2025. The project aims to economically empower community women through the strengthening of women-led entrepreneurship, creation of employment opportunities, awareness raising on women's rights, and developing linkages with policy makers in the implementation of women-related laws. Under the project successfully established 46 new business ventures, and provided 20 jobs for women and youth.

6. Joint Social Action for Inclusive Society

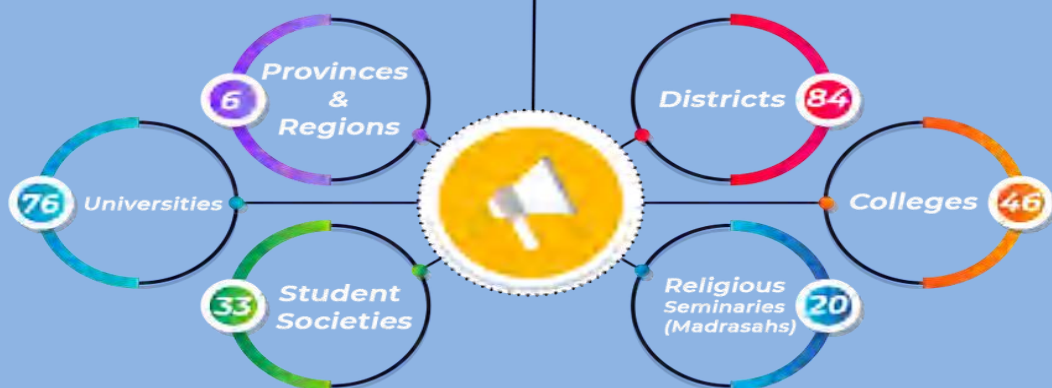
Bargad adopted an integrated approach by engaging all key stakeholders to improve protection and participation of vulnerable groups as well as strengthening Community Peace Groups (CPGs) in eight/8 Union Councils (UCs) of Lahore. The project resolved 13 conflicts in communities.

7. Socio-Economic Recovery of Afghan Refugee Women- Girls in Punjab & Balochistan

The project started in 2022 and will conclude in 2024. The focus of the project is social development and economic recovery of Afghan refugee women and girls in Balochistan and Punjab. The need assessment has been completed which provided the baseline for project result framework
